KSR COACHES' CODE OF CONDUCT

KSR has great coaching volunteers, parents and families, but it is always important to **remember that we are dealing with children and that we should not get caught up in the competitive moment.** We don't want to be remembered as the 'yellers and screamers.' Set a great sportsmanship example by cheering and encouraging players for both teams. A good play is a good play. Not all coaches from other organizations will demonstrate the same high level of decorum that we expect of our coaches. Do not lower yourselves to their level.

All assistant coaches, players and parents are the responsibility of the head coach. The home plate umpire has the full authority and discretion to eject any coach, player or parent which will also result in the head coach being ejected for that game. Behaviors that can lead to ejection include but are not limited to:

- Alcohol on site or signs of inebriation
- Verbal abuse of players, coaches, umpires or other parents
- Unsportsmanlike conduct
- Offensive language
- Physical contact with players, coaches, umpires or other parents

Any coach who is ejected from a game for any reason including the behavior of their assistant coaches, players or parents will need to provide a written summary of the event to their respective baseball/softball director prior to any further contact with the team. The KSR Board has the authority to levy penalties that include but are not limited to:

- Suspension for additional game(s)
- Suspension from the league for remainder of the season
- Permanent suspension from the league at which point you will not be allowed within 75' of the playing fields.

The KSR Board's decision can be appealed in writing. A hearing will be held within 1 week to determine whether the appropriate penalty has been levied after which the decision will be considered FINAL.

All coaches will also abide by Codes of Conduct as dictated by their respective leagues and/or tournaments (*GLASAGSL for softball, TCBA for Bronco and Pony baseball and Tippecanoe Mustang-Pinto League.*)

KSR coaches are **subject to a criminal background check** to ensure safety of the children they may coach. By your signature below, you authorize KSR to conduct a criminal background check.
